



## Framework of Burundi Strategy




Simplified framework for Health in all Policies in Burundi

## 3. Objectives of the Strategy:





- ☐ Burundi's participation in the International Health Network in all policies
- □Organization of a national strategy launch conference coupled with a Resource Mobilization Round Table for the implementation of the strategy.
